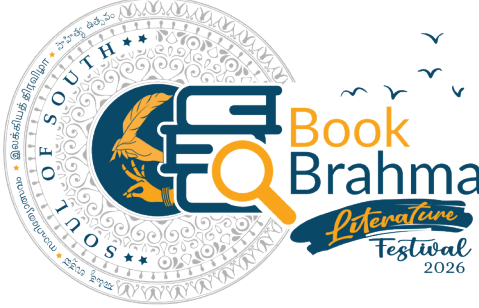

Ramakka and I: Shilpa Mudbi and Ramavva Jogathi

“Ramakka and I” is an intimate, unscripted encounter between Ramavva Jogathi, a transwoman folk artist from rural Karnataka, and Shilpa Mudbi, a theatre practitioner and researcher. United by nearly a decade of friendship and shared engagement with the Joga tradition of North Karnataka, they explore their lives through conversation, song, memory, and humour.

Their exchange reveals how caste, class, gender, and the rural–urban divide shape identity, labour, and lived experience. Yet their differences become a space for listening, companionship, and understanding.

Woven with Jogathi songs and lived memories, the performance is a moving reflection on survival, resilience, and the radical act of staying in conversation.

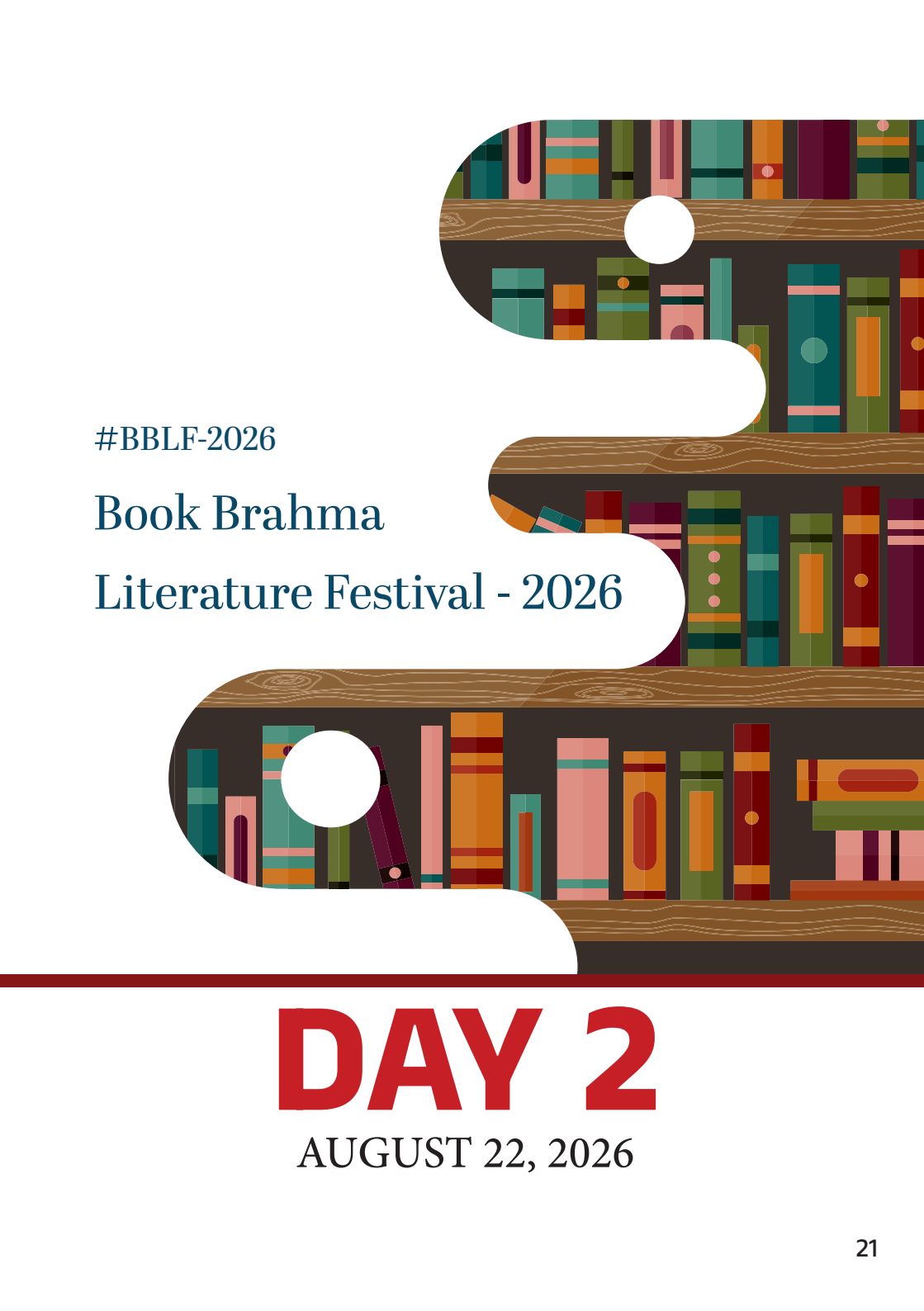
